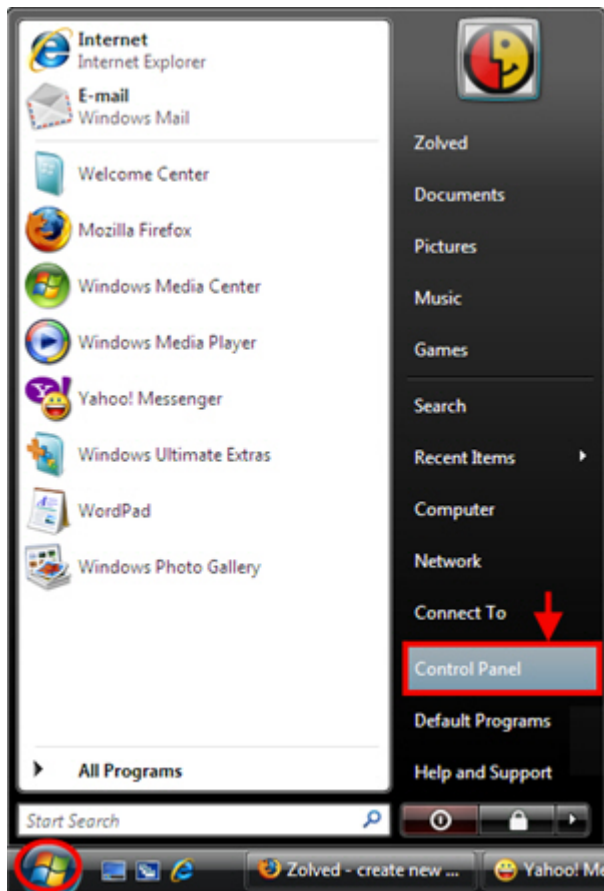
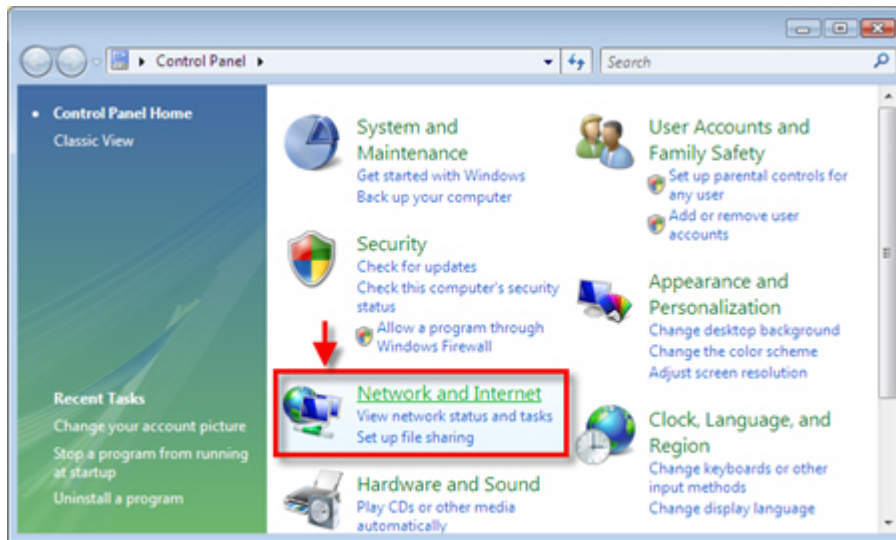


Creating A Dialer On Windows Vista

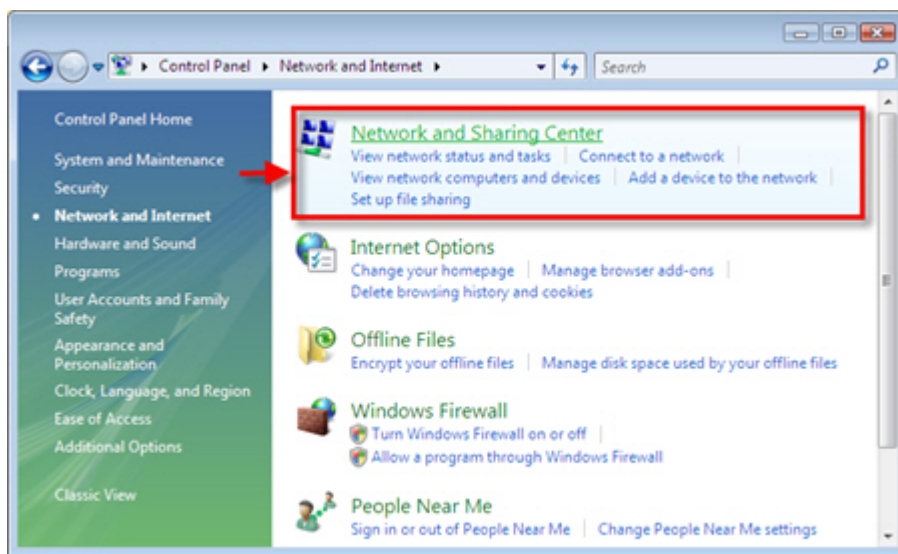
1. Click **Start** -> **Control Panel**.



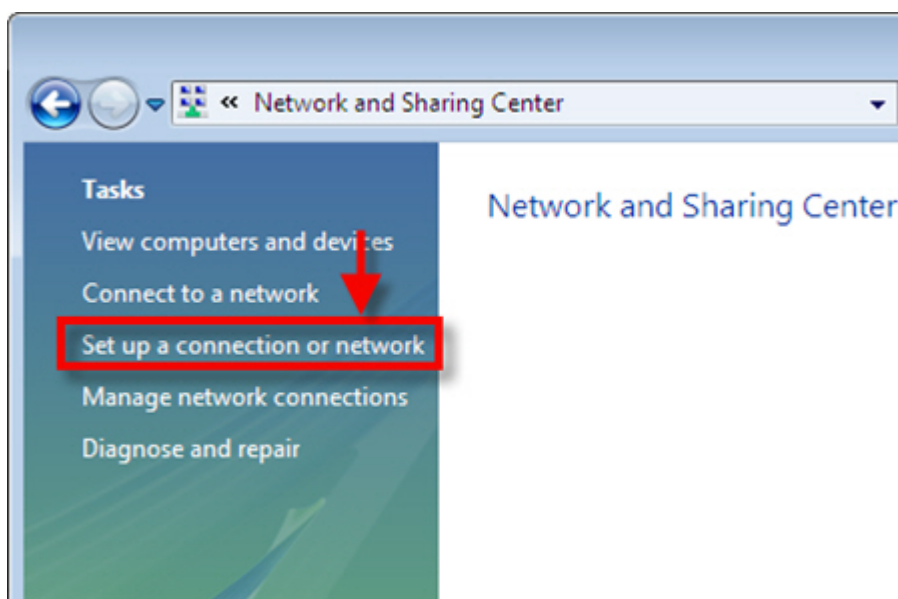
2. Click on **Network and Internet** icon.



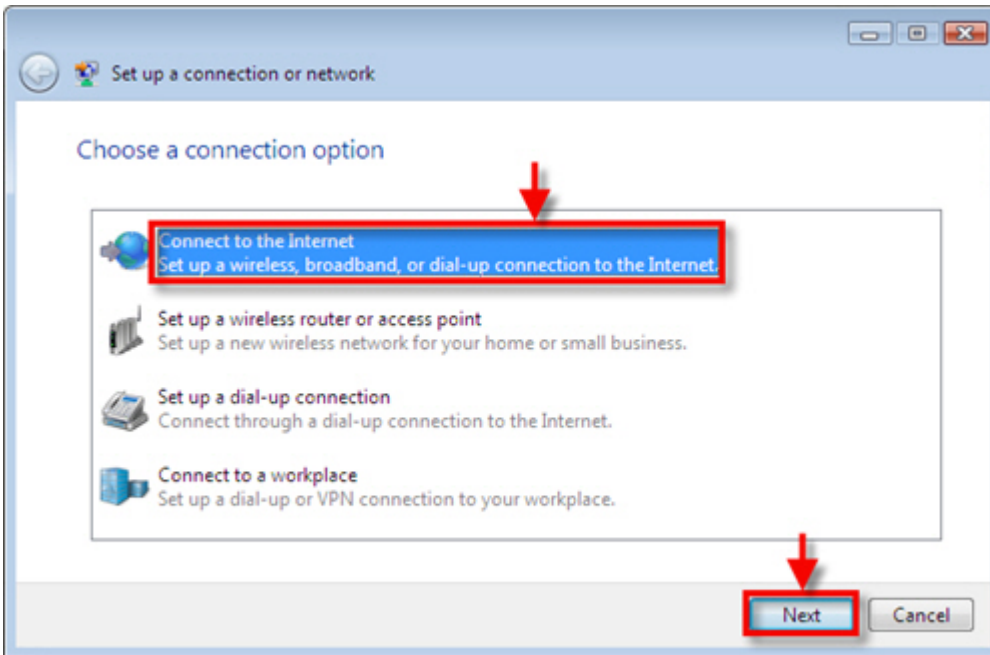
3. Click on **Network and Sharing Center** icon.



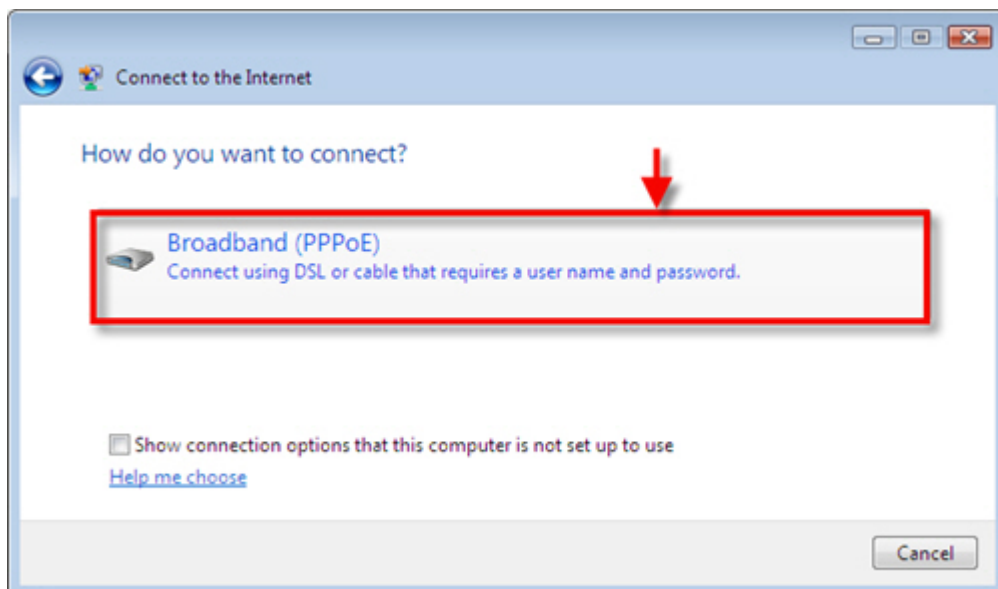
4. Click on **Setup a connection or network** on the left task pane.



5. A new window will popup asking you to choose the connection option. Click **Connect to the Internet** and click **Next**.



6. Now click on **Broadband (PPPoE)** option.



7. Do the following on this screen:

- Enter the **User name** and **Password** your ISP gave you.
- Type in a name for **Connection name**. This name is to identify your internet connection. (If you have multiple Internet connections, this is useful).
- If you check the box which says "**Allow other people to use this connection**", Vista will allow all the users on the computer to access this connection.

8. Click **Connect**.

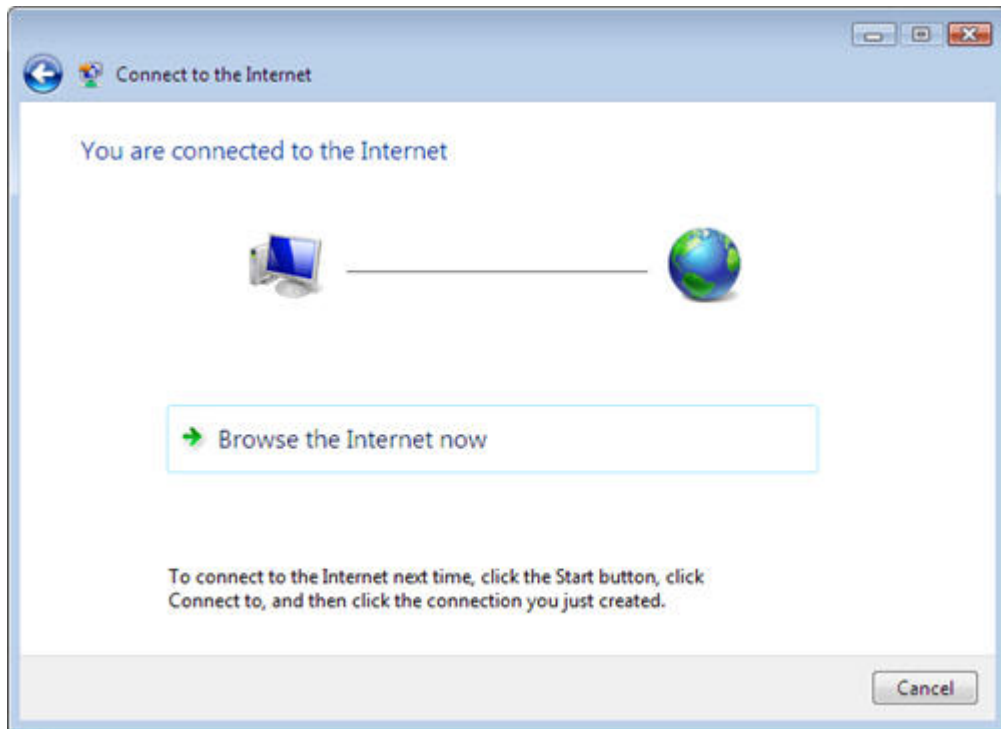
